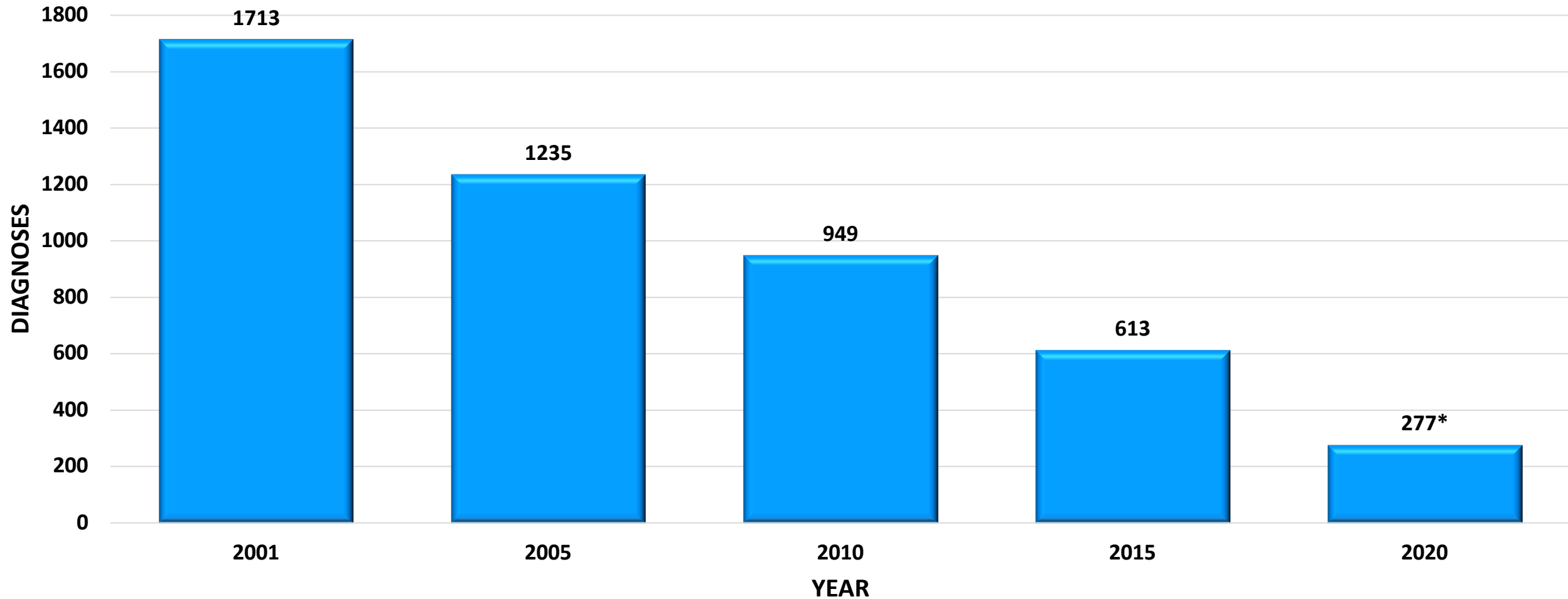

NYC: HIV DIAGNOSES AGE 40+, 2001-2020

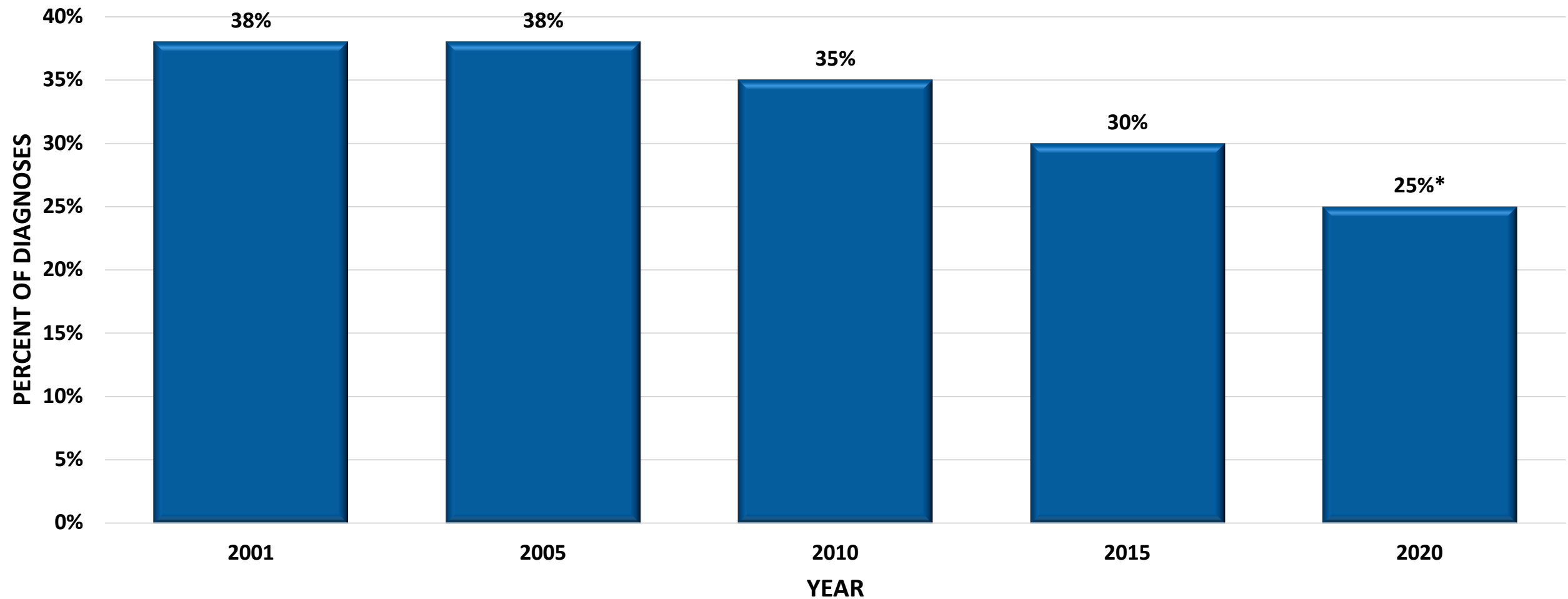

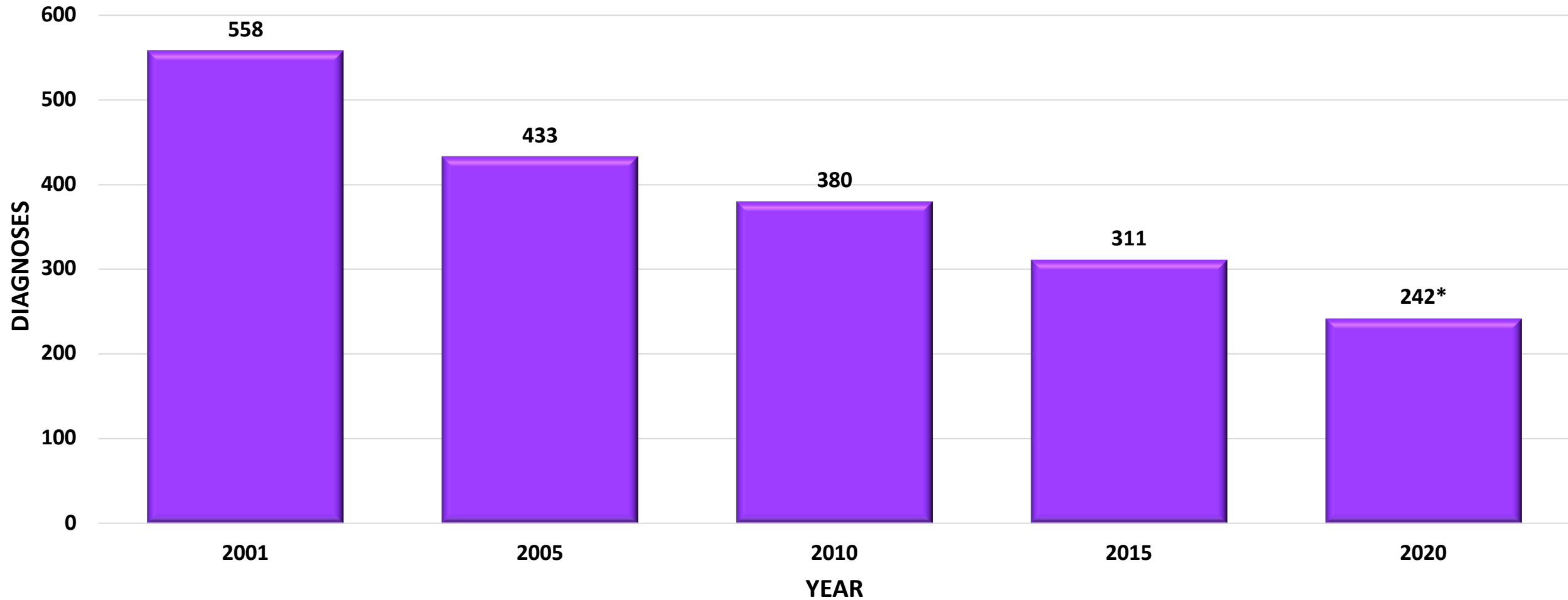
NYC: % HIV DIAGNOSES AGE 40+, 2001-2020

NYC: HIV DIAGNOSES AGE 50+, 2001-2020

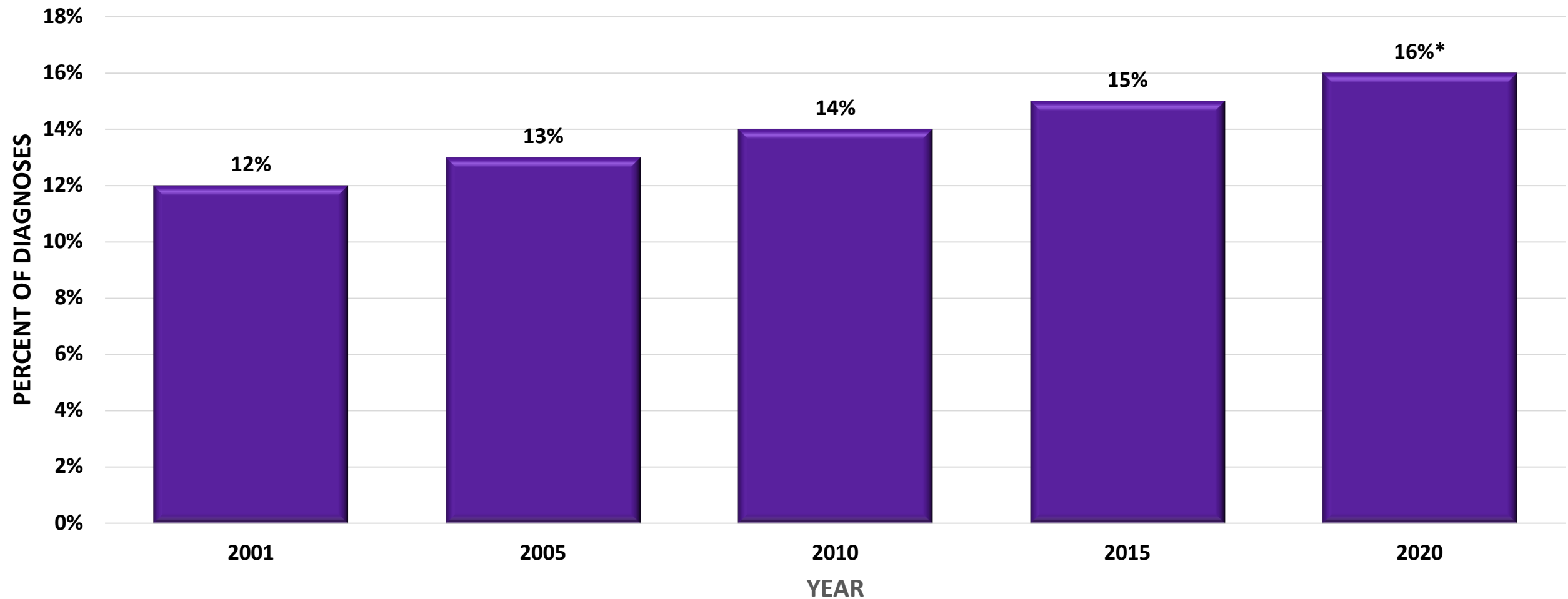

NYC: % HIV DIAGNOSES AGE 50+, 2001-2020

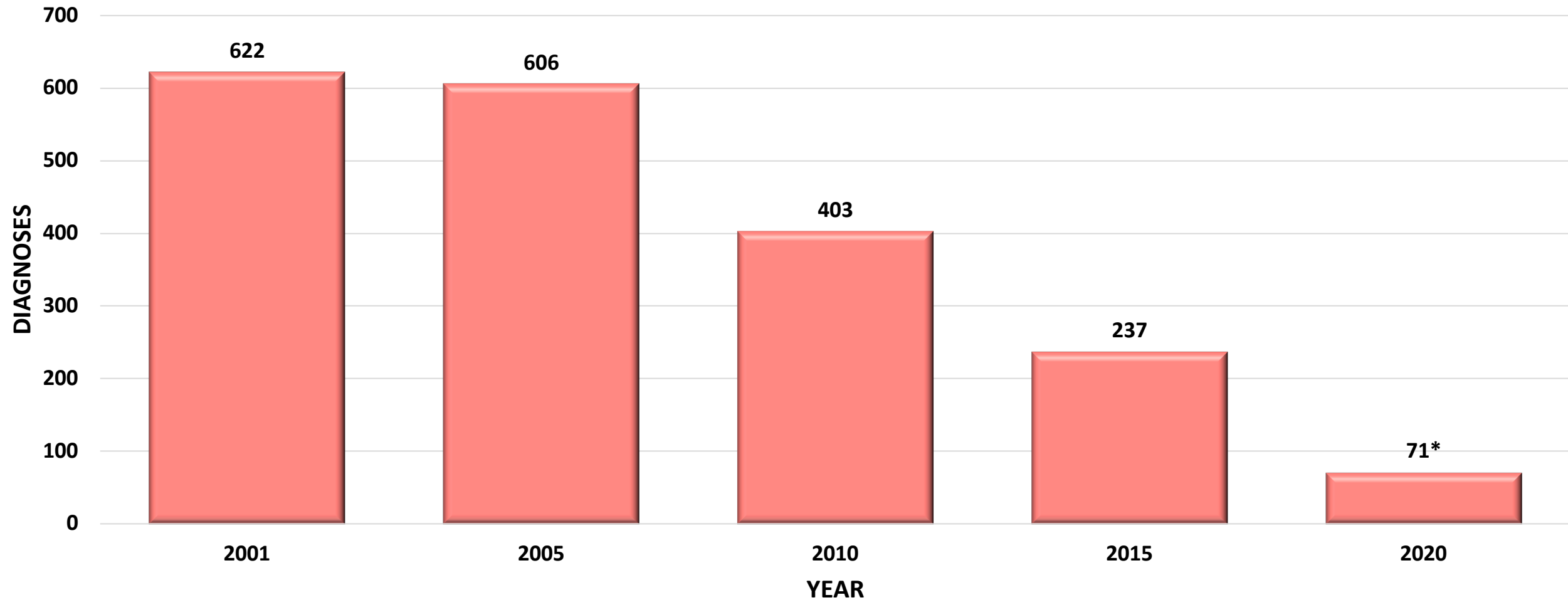

NYC: HIV CONCURRENT WITH AIDS DIAGNOSES AGE 40+, 2001-2020

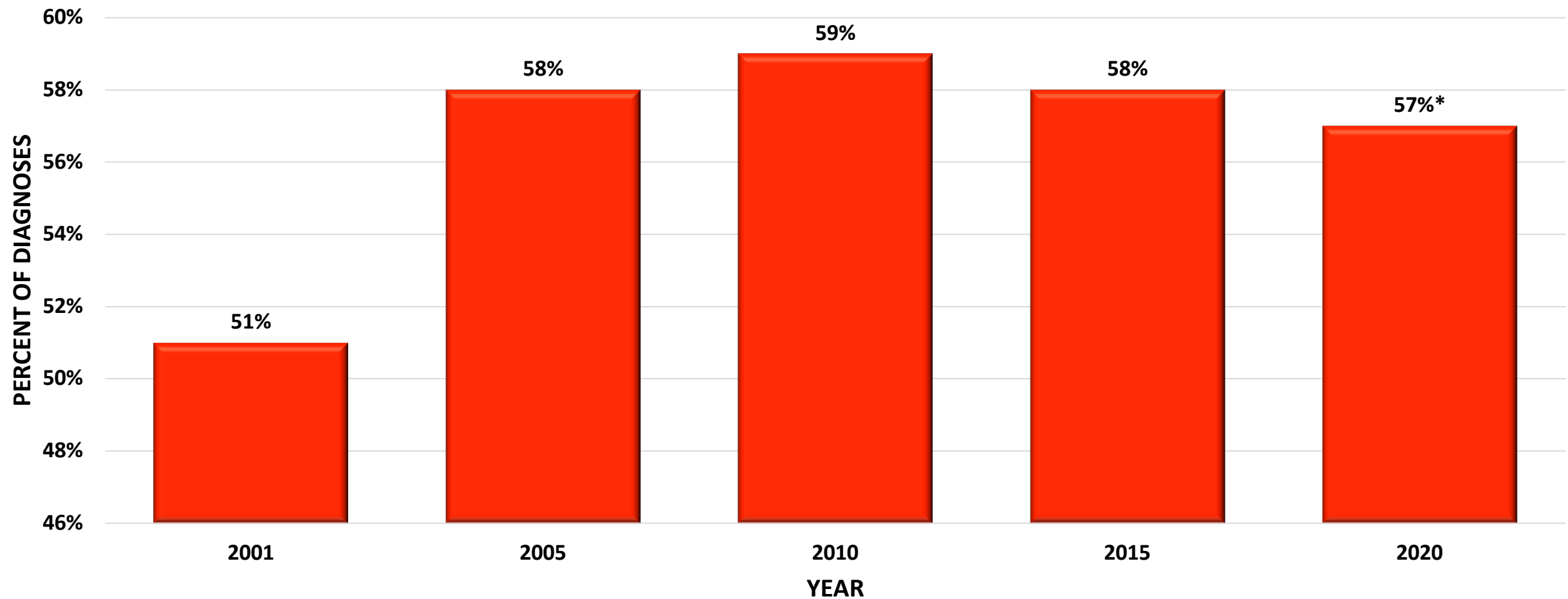

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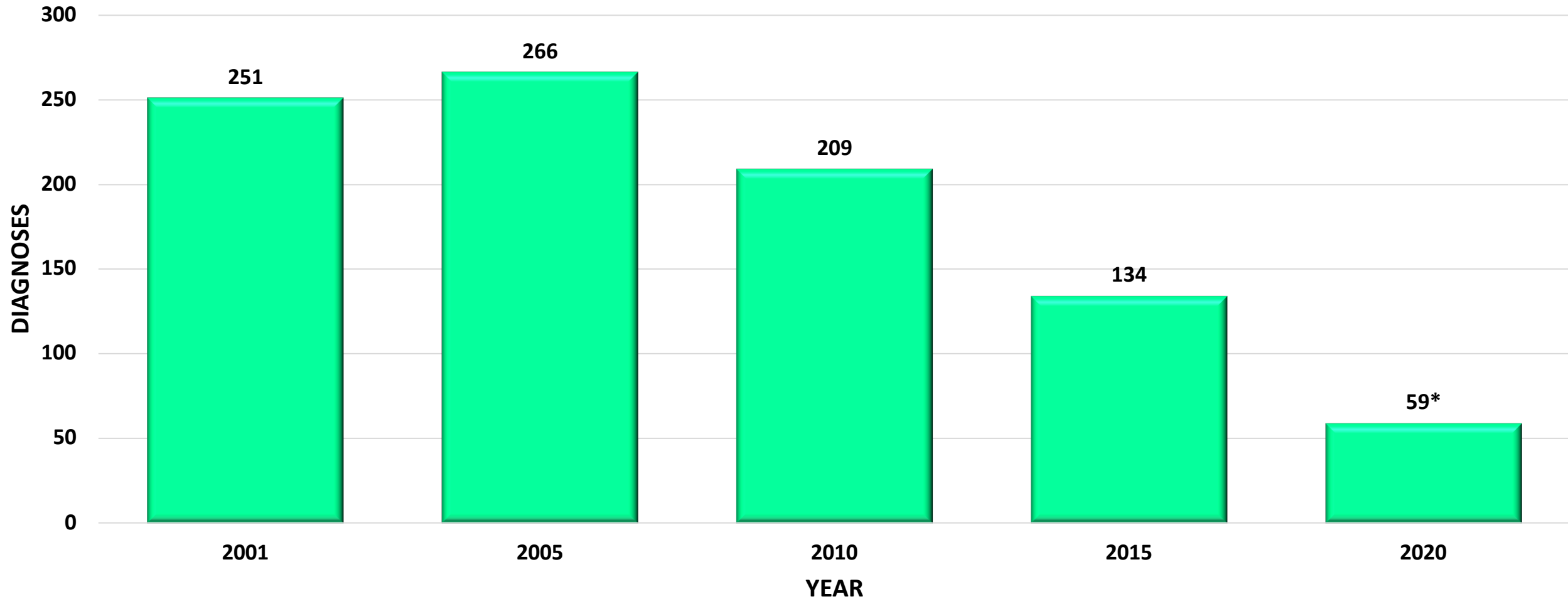
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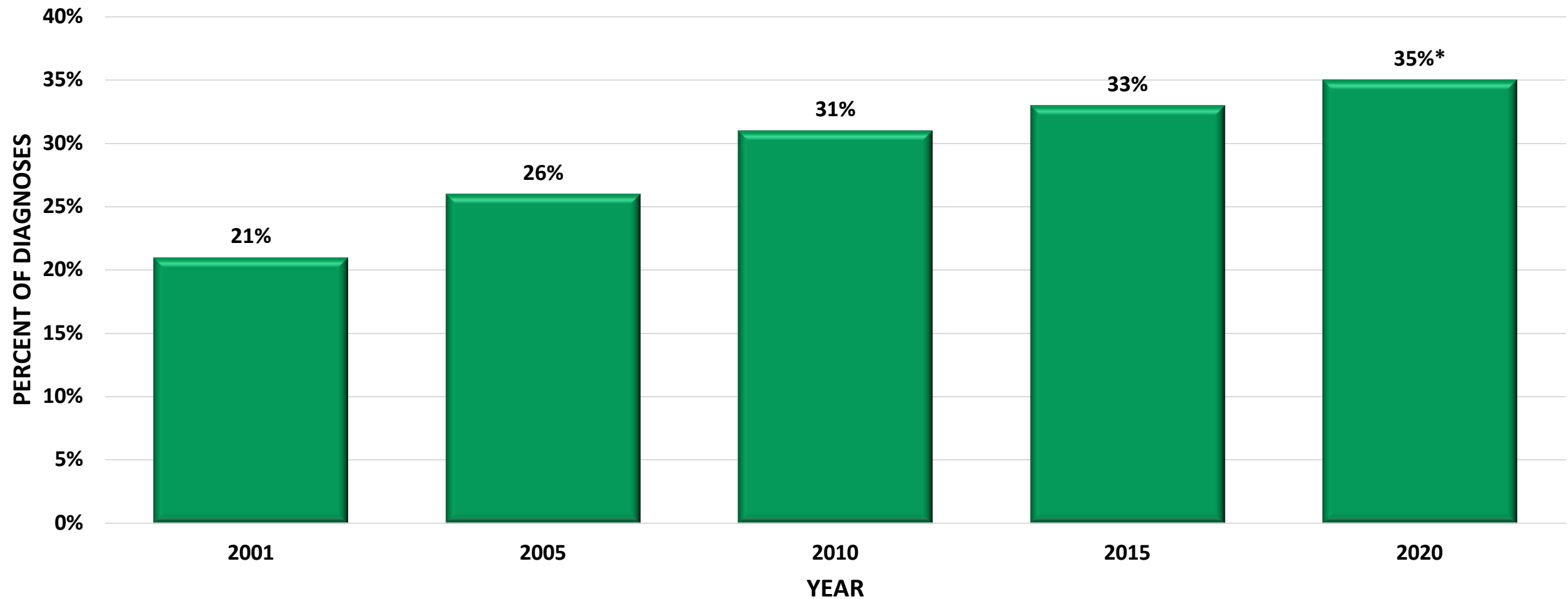


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
