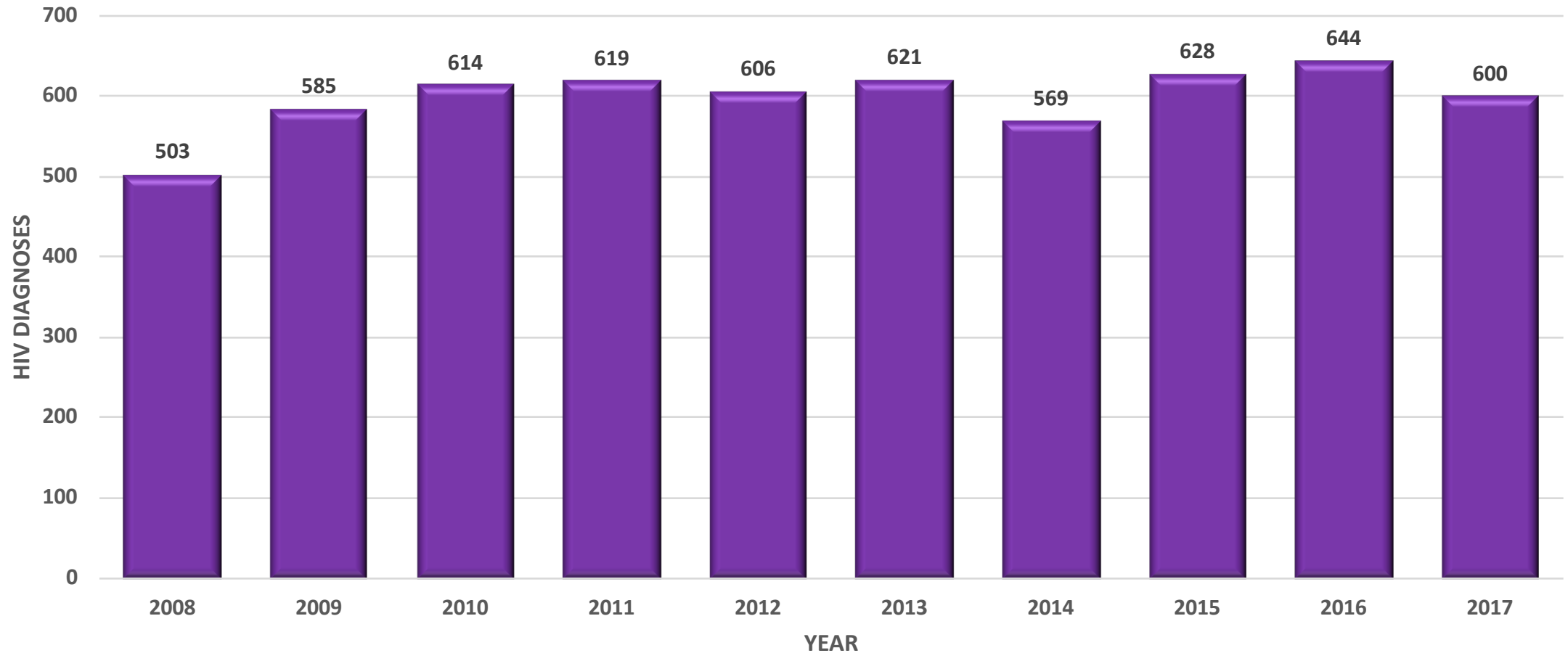

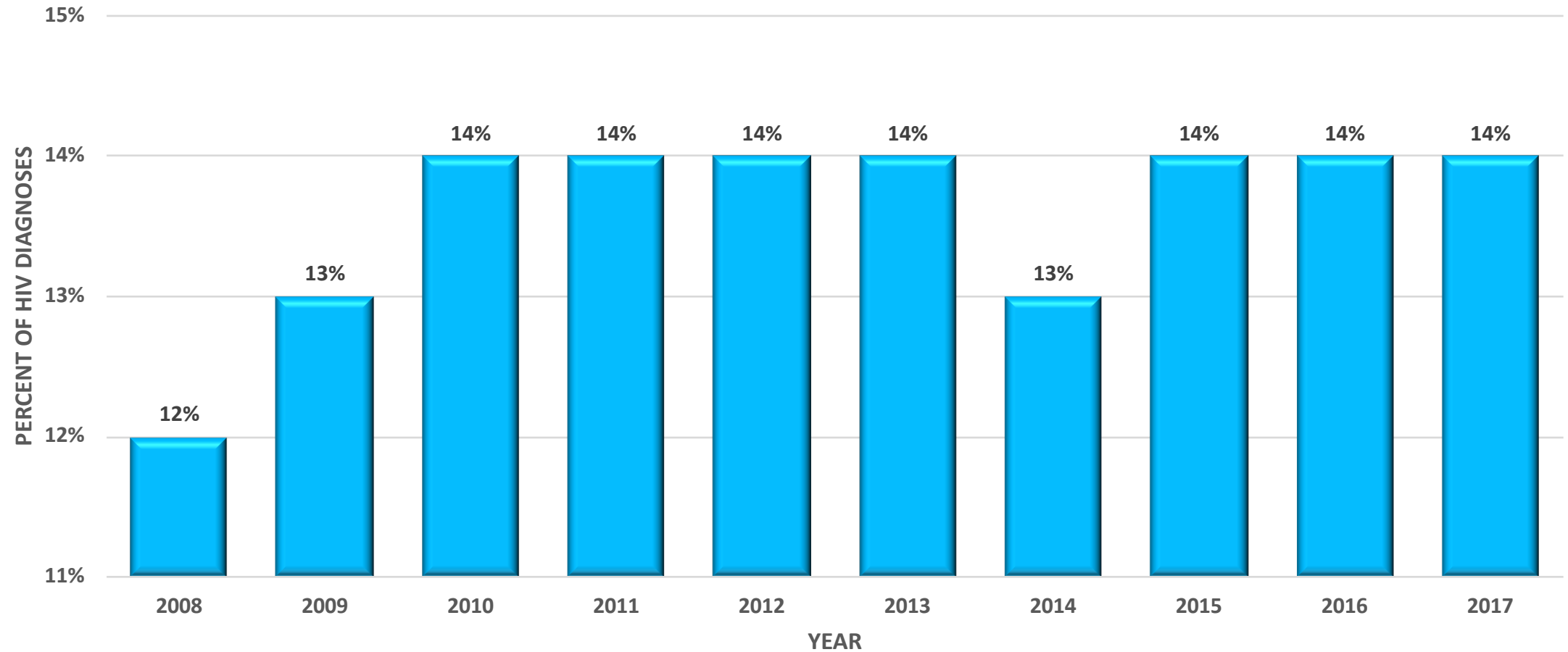
NUMBER OF HIV DIAGNOSES AMONG THOSE AGE 50 AND OLDER IN TEXAS 2008-2017

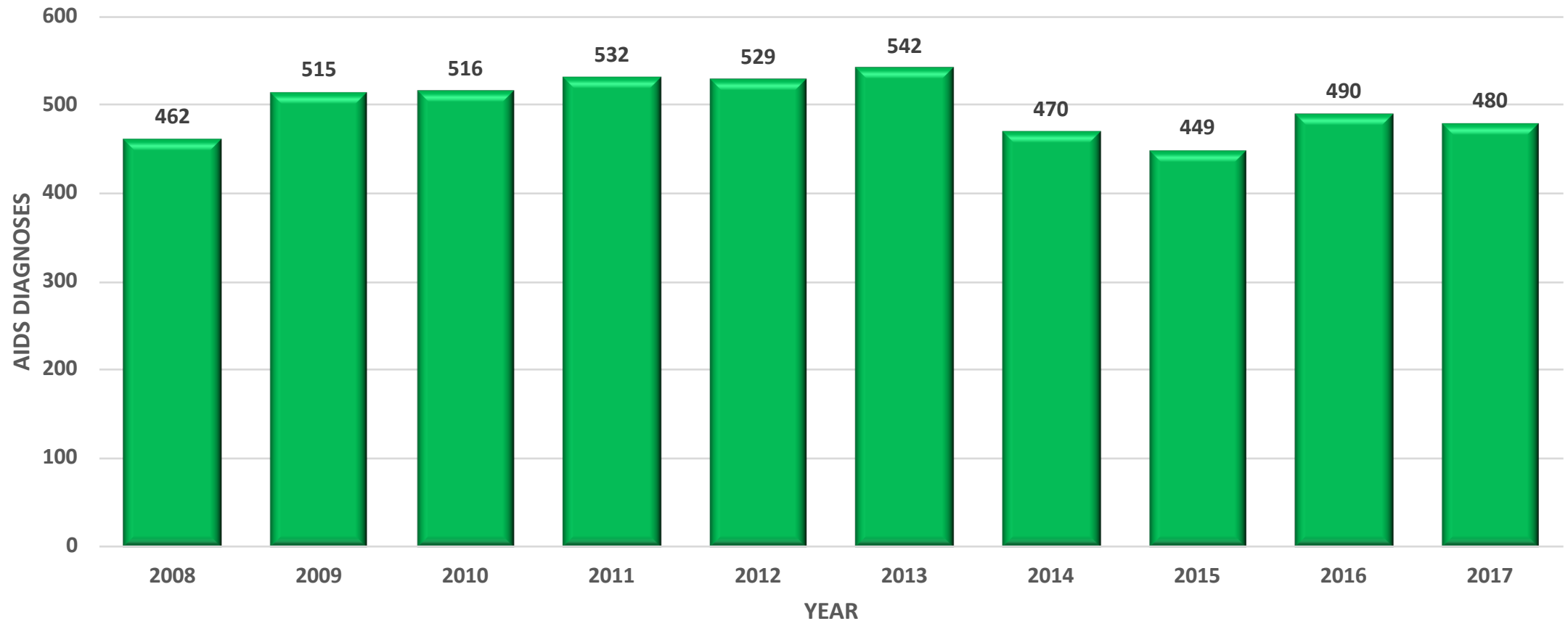
PERCETAGE OF PEOPLE DIAGNOSED WITH HIV IN TEXAS AGE 50 AND OLDER 2008-2017

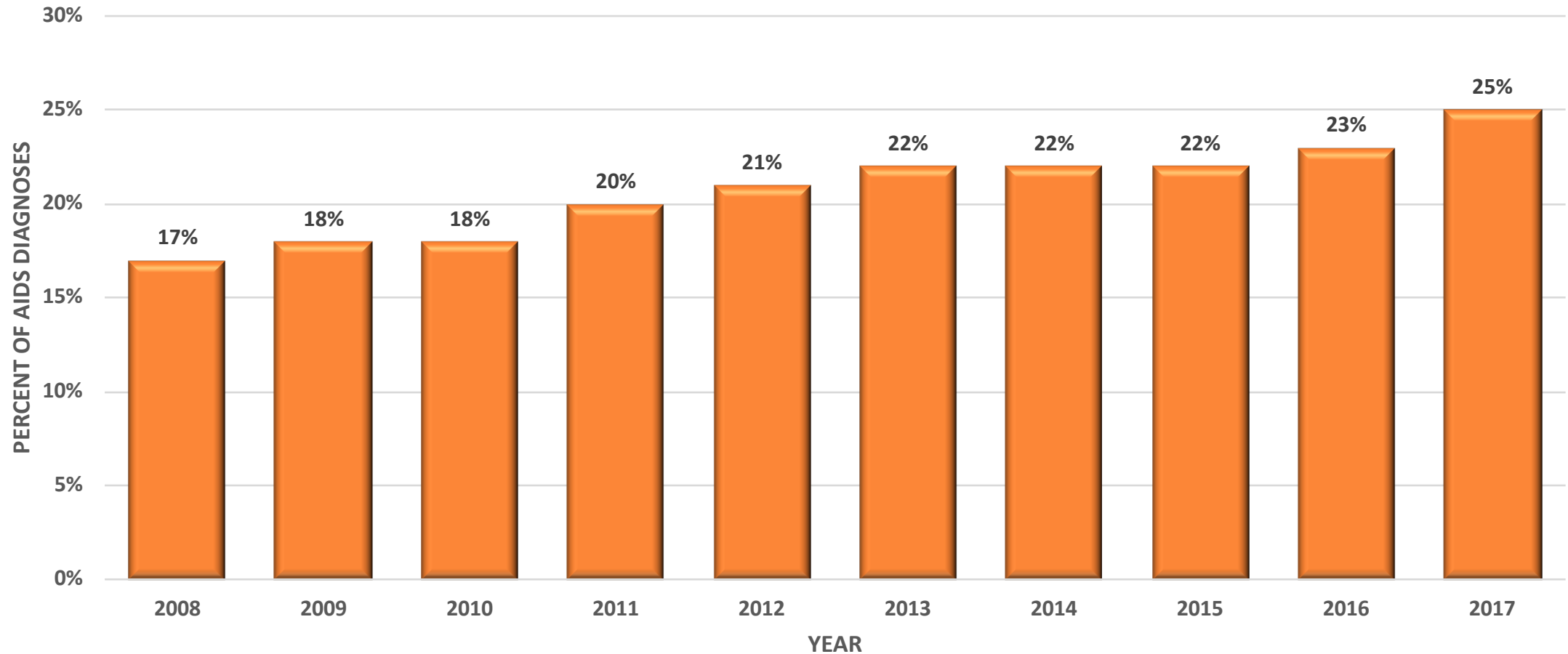
NUMBER OF AIDS DIAGNOSES AMONG THOSE AGE 50 AND OLDER IN TEXAS 2008-2017

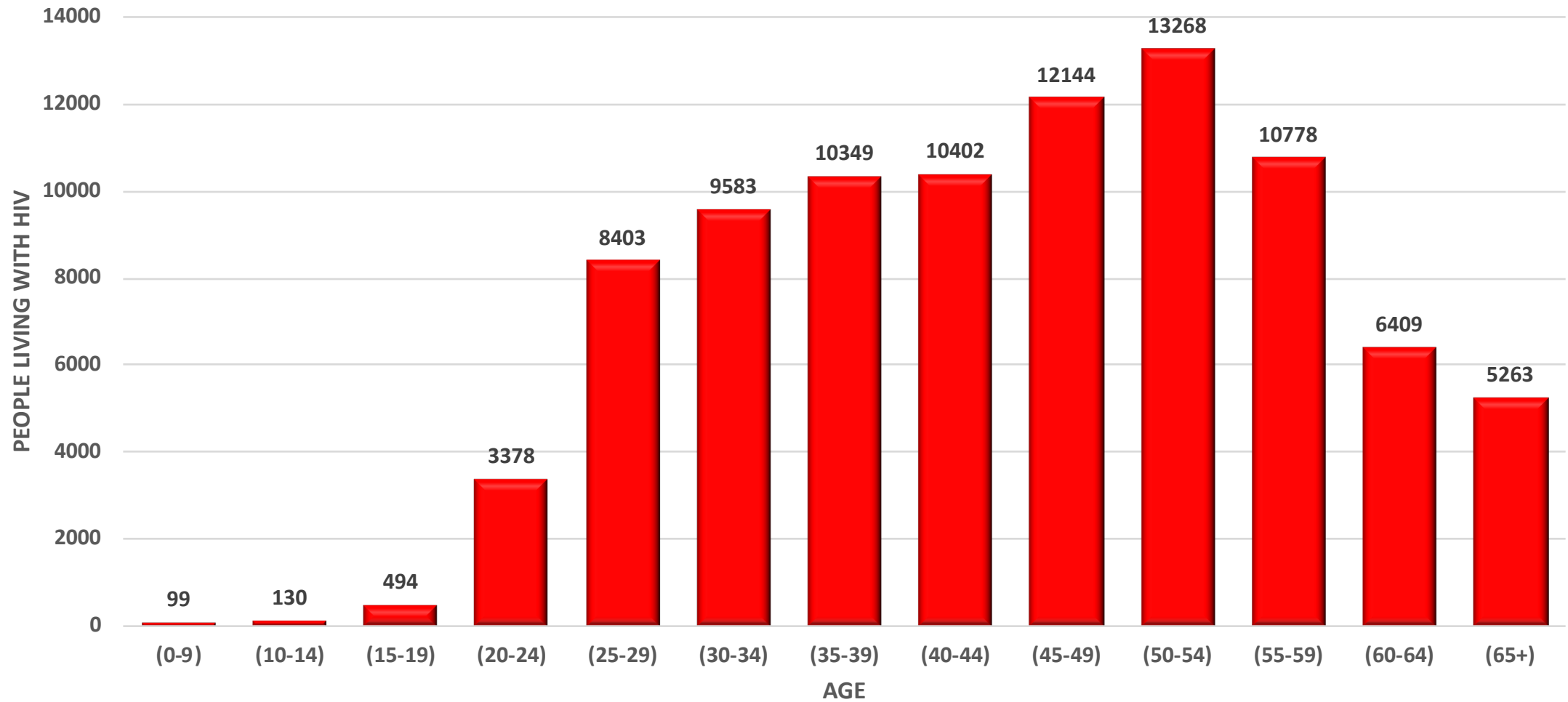
PERCETAGE OF PEOPLE DIAGNOSED WITH AIDS IN TEXAS AGE 50 AND OLDER 2008-2017
